


Higher-paying, mid-skill jobs:

What colleges and vocational institutions offer degree and certificate programs for these jobs?



Twenty-five colleges and vocational institutions granted degrees and certificates in programs that prepare individuals for higher-paying, mid-skill jobs in 2013. These institutions granted over 4,900 degrees and certificates for higher-paying, mid-skill jobs. Over half were granted by the region's three community colleges. The large majority of students who enroll in community college are young adults under the age of 25. Adults age 25+ account for a third or less of total enrollment.

Private colleges and vocational schools account for the second largest generators of degrees and certificates for higher-paying, mid-skill jobs. These include not-for-profit institutions as well as for-profit schools. It is more common for these institutions to enroll larger percentages of adults age 25+. At several, over three-quarters of those who enroll are age 25+.

BOCES and other public colleges together granted over 1,000 degrees for higher-paying, mid-skills jobs, with SUNY College of Technology at Alfred being the largest generator.
